Students are expected to clearly demonstrate growth during the year in order to progress to the next year level. Teachers are expected to fully support students to achieve success.
Aims	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To establish a culture of high expectation, insistence and support.• To establish a process for supporting a student at risk of not meeting the expectations.• To provide a consistency of practice across the College with regard to assessment, thereby supporting student learning and wellbeing.
Implementation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Expectations with respect to attendance, effort and achievement will be clearly conveyed to all students and parents/carers.• Students who are not meeting the expectations will be identified.• There will be strong lines of communication between the teachers and parents/carers of students who are at risk.• A range of strategies will be put in place to support students to achieve success.• A student must be able to demonstrate readiness in order to progress from one year level to the next year level. Key indicators may include: task completion, attendance, involvement in catch up classes and Homework Club as well as work submission.
