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| Preamble | Mill Park Secondary College values the rich learning experiences that integrated interactions with technology bring. The Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program is a critical step towards meeting the dynamic needs of our students and empowering students with direct involvement in the way digital technologies are used in their learning. |
| Aim | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To allow students to use an approved device to access the College wireless network and software for educational purposes.• To enable students to use technology to further their learning independently and in structured lessons.• To enable students to develop skills and behaviours reflective of responsible digital citizens. |
| Implementation | Mill Park Secondary College will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Implement an Equity Policy to ensure students have access to a computing resource.• Provide a BYOD User Agreement to list the responsibilities and expectations of each student and their families in the BYOD program. This Agreement will be made available and sighted each time a student logs onto wireless network.• Publish a Device Specification Guide that indicates the minimum requirements for devices.• Accept no responsibility for loss or damage to, or for maintenance or repair required in a student's own device through any act or omission resulting from the negligence or otherwise of the school, a member of the school staff or of another student. |
