2021 Scholarship PROGRAM



Mill Park Secondary College offers a range of scholarships in the following areas:

Academic

Academic Scholarships are awarded to students who have displayed outstanding academic success in primary school and in the aptitude test for the College's SEAL, STEM or Accelerated English programs.

Performing Arts

Performing Arts Scholarships are awarded to students who have displayed aptitude and potential in the field of dance, drama and/or music activities at primary school and in the community. Applicants should have a record of involvement in all aspects of primary school life and extracurricular activities in addition to their performing arts talents.

Sporting

Sporting Scholarships are awarded to students who have been involved in a range of sporting activities at primary school and in the community. Applicants should demonstrate outstanding sporting talents such as the attributes of fairness, cooperation and leadership.

Community — Good Citizenship

Community Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate good citizenship through their involvement in all aspects of primary school life. These students should be "all rounders", including involvement in student leadership, extra curricular activities as well as a strong academic performance.

Student Leadership

Student Leadership Scholarships are awarded to students who have a history of involvement in a range of primary school based student leadership activities including Student Council, being a House Captain or Peer Mentoring.

SELECTION

Selection for all scholarships is based on written application and interview. You should also include a current school report or reference letter to support your application. In addition, applicants for academic scholarships are required to test for the SEAL and Accelerated Programs. Scholarships are awarded for two years.

APPLICATION

Please fill out and return the attached expression of interest form to the College to receive a full set of application forms. Application forms must be completed and returned to the College no later than **Friday 5 June 2020**. Applicants for the Academic scholarship must sit the Aptitude Test for acceptance into the SEAL or Accelerated Programs (A separate brochure and application forms are available on request)

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Applicants for all scholarships must have an excellent academic and behavioural record. In addition to scholarship specific requirements, all applicants must be able to demonstrate at interview and by written application, that they possess personal qualities and values which will contribute significantly to the life of this College.

The College will only award scholarships, if the applicant is of the highest standard.

Families need to understand that it is not possible to award a scholarship to every worthy applicant and will abide by the final decision of the College personnel.

The Community Engagement Coordinator will closely monitor all scholarship recipients. Poor performance by a scholarship student may result in a scholarship being revoked.

All applicants will be notified of the result of their application by letter and will abide by the decision of the College. Late applications cannot be accepted by the College.
