




How does VCE work?

- In Victoria, there are two pathway options for senior secondary students across Years 11 and 12:
 - Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or
 - VCE Vocational Major (VCE VM)
- Students can also complete a Vocational Education and Training (VET) certificate during Year 11 and 12
 - *All VCE VM students must complete a VET subject



Year 10 VCE and VET early start

- Students have the opportunity to choose a VCE or VET subject to study in Year 10.
- Choosing one VCE subject in Year 10 will replace two elective choices.
- When choosing a VET in Year 10, this will take place at MPSC Wednesday session 5 and 6.
- Students that study a VCE / VET in Year 10 will usually continue this subject in Year 11, meaning that they have completed a Year 12 subject at the end of Year 11.

Year 10 VCE and VET Early Start

To be eligible students must:

- Have demonstrated a consistent record of achievement
- Have a genuine interest in the subject
- Have an excellent attendance record
- Have demonstrated the maturity required to be successful in a course at an advanced year level



VCE subjects for early start

- See page 8 of the Handbook.
- Students should not pick their favourite subject to do as an early start but a related subject from the list given.
- e.g. favourite subject Biology. Save this until Year 11.
 - related subjects Psychology, Health and Human
 Development, VET Lab Skills. Choose one of these in Year 10.

VCE Vocational Major

- A new program within the VCE
- Replaces VCAL
- Applied learning and standards based assessment
- Students MUST do a VET subject & other compulsory subjects

Victorian Certificate of Education

- Standards based assessment and external examinations
- Leading to an ATAR

VCE Vocational Major

Two year vocational and applied learning program within the VCE for students within Year 11 and Year 12

- Leads to TAFE, apprenticeships, working
- No Exams
- VET is a requirement
- Work Placement 1 day a week. Yr 11 semester 2, Yr 12 all year.

Students who are interested in VCE VM will be identified during careers conversations or can see the Careers team during break times

- You will need a <u>USI</u> to apply
